The history of Marrakech begins with its foundation in 1062 by Youssef ben Tachfine, head of the Almoravid dynasty. They established schools of Koranic theology, conquering the whole of Morocco. Ben Tachfine is considered the father of Morocco.


The Almoravid caliph Abd al-Mumin had two mosques built, one of them the famous Koutoubia Mosque, inspired by Al-Andalus art and reminiscent of the Giralda Mosque.

Following the defeat of the Almoravids, the Almohad dynasty took over - they were called the "unifiers" of Berber Islam. The Almohad era was a period of great influence for Marrakech. Numerous buildings recall the splendor of this era, such as the majestic entrance to the Kasbah, a fortress housing a mosque.

In 1230, al-Maymun of the Benimerine dynasty, aided by Ferdinand II, conquered Marrakech. Shortly afterwards, his brother Abu Yusuf ousted the Almohads and Benimerines who had ruled for two centuries. During the Bénimérine era, the city fell somewhat into oblivion; today, there are no vestiges of its past.


The Benimerin dynasty was followed by that of the Wattassids, before power passed into the hands of the Cherif dynasty.

The Cherifs are the descendants of the Prophet Mohammed through his daughter Fatima, married to Ali. The name of Muhammad's son-in-law, Ali, gave rise to the Alawite dynasty, to which the current King of Morocco belongs. This is why the kingdom is called the "Alawite Kingdom", formerly known as the "Cherifian Empire."









The Cherif family took power in the 16th century. The Bab Doukkala, Mouassine and Saïd Al-Jazouli mosques, the Ben Youssef medersa (1570) and the tomb of the Saadian Al-Mansour and his family all date from this period.

Marrakech has played host to most of the important historical events that have shaped Morocco's identity. The Portuguese, Spanish and French first drove out the corsairs to control and take advantage of the natural resources and privileged location at the gateway to Africa.

Until Morocco's independence in 1956, Marrakech enjoyed a turbulent history, with rare periods of peace, often due to the ambitions of European countries.

In 1911, Morocco's capital became Rabat, relegating Marrakech to second place. Today, it is a city that lives mainly from tourism, agricultural products exported to Europe, and canned fruit and vegetables. It is the region's commercial center and a hub for the transportation of minerals mined in the Atlas Mountains.


AGAFAY DESERT






Departure

The journey begins by crossing the length of the Atlas Mountains on the Tishka pass, stopping to take photos in picturesque spots. Next, you'll be driven to the perfect village of Ait Ben Haddou, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. You should be there around 12:00. Read less

2/ Ksar of Ait-Ben-Haddou On arrival, you'll be introduced to your local guide. Lunch in a restaurant of your choice. (Please note that your guide and lunch are not included in today's tour). The guide will accompany you to the restaurant to eat, and after your meal, he will pick you up for a guided tour of the village.

3/ Ouarzazate Once you're done with the sites at Ait Benhaddou. You'll be driven 45 minutes to the town of Ouarzazate. On arrival. You'll have time to explore the town, in particular the Kasbah Tawrirt. You'll also have time to visit the Cenema Studio.
